Friends,

The RSS-BJP government led by the Modi-Shah duo, its “double-engine” governments and other state governments have launched an avalanche of pro-Corporate and pro-Landlord attacks on the Indian peasantry. It is our duty to expose, propagate and agitate against these relentless attacks—to save the peasantry, save agriculture, protect forests and nature, and save the country from these brutal, wild and cruel economic assaults.

Big Corporations, led by giant Western MNCs are seeking to establish their control over every sector of the agricultural economy. Through the deliberate withdrawal and weakening of government supply systems and controls, they are dominating the supply of seeds, fertilizers, electricity, machinery and services. This is seriously indebting farmers, while enabling companies to dictate cropping patterns. They are increasingly dominating mandis, retail markets, food processing and exports, particularly in high-value products. Their Free Trade Agreements are designed to facilitate cheap imports of highly subsidized agricultural products from imperialist countries. That will ruin Indian farmers. Already we suffer negative subsidy with taxes on inputs. Farmer earnings are falling.

Land rights and rights over water resources, fishing and sand mining of the village poor and Dalits, as well as the Forest Rights of Tribals, are under attack. Big Corporations are grabbing these resources for real estate business, large-scale mining, townships, ecologically disastrous power plants, transmission towers, Data Centres, Highways, Economic Corridors, big Dams for commercial water supply and other projects.

At the same time, the promotion of Big Landlord and land-mafia interests, combined with fascist, ‘Manuvadi’, ‘Hindutwa’ ideology, is dividing people along communal lines and threatening the rights and survival of minorities. It is degrading the enforcement of Dalit Rights and Women’s Rights, increasing caste atrocities, forcing women into cheaper labour, and protecting and patronising sexual exploiters.

These forces are strengthening attacks by the village toughs and making it increasingly difficult for the village poor—including in tribal areas—to retain and secure their lands. They are undermining the Zamindari Abolition, Land Ceiling and Forest Rights Acts, as well as their own so-called Panchayati Raj. The attack on free government education facilities and free Health care and promotion of privatization are important accompaniments of these attacks.

The Central Government has attacked state rights and peasants even further. This includes the Bill to privatize Electricity, increase tariffs and impose smart meters. The G RAM G Act, replacing MGNREGA undermines the right to work and job guarantee, condemns the poor to low wages, promotes cheaper labour for landlords and village-level Corporate projects and shifts the financial responsibility for implementation onto state governments. The Seed Bill, grants greater freedom to MNCs to import costly, genetically and environmentally harmful seeds, promotes black marketing of seeds and penalizes local seed traders and farmers.

The three Farm Laws were imposed with the aim of uprooting peasants on a large scale by snatching away their livelihood. We fought back valiantly. AIKMS led from the front, braving repression, water cannons and tear gas shelling, police baton charges and cases, insulting name-calling by the RSS and Modi government, and repeated manoeuvres to divide us.

We stood our ground, challenged the legal diversions and forced the government to withdraw the three Farm Laws. We remained positive to the end in building a united front of peasants, as in the SKM, and in pushing forward the demands for Minimum Support Price at 1.5 times the comprehensive input costs (C2+50%) and that of Debt Waiver.

We have fought for Land Rights, Forest Rights and Wage Rights of the poor.

The government has waived Rs 16 lakh crore of corporate debts but has refused to accept the needs of its annadatas. It is friendly with foreign companies and Corporations that devour the economy, while remaining unresponsive to its own patriotic working people. It wants to build a Corporate-controlled India by devastating people's lives.

We need to build a New India with a New Agriculture Policy that is Pro-Farmer, Pro-Nature and Patriotic.

This RSS-BJP government has severely undermined the social and political fabric of India—that India which was delivered on 15 August 1947 with a promise to build a

secular society, ensure social justice, keep India free from foreign exploiters and looters, establish democratic governance and secure a federal fabric of state rights.

As the crisis grows, attacks on the people are becoming more vicious. The SIR will deny people their right to “vote out” governments. The bulldozers physically crush people’s life assets. The invocation of “Threat to National Security” and the UAPA terrorist labels, ideologically condemns patriots.

But truth cannot be caged for long.

The patriotic struggle of Naxalbari against big landlords and foreign loot, carried forward by the poorest sons and daughters of India, has also been pinned as “Dimagi”. It is precisely this struggle that the Corporates and Landlords fear most.

We must reply with force and determination.

Let us raise our voice high and build our strength wide around the following main demands:

- Remove Corporate Control over Agriculture and Food Markets.
- Against Landlords and Feudal Atrocities.
- For Agricultural and Homestead Land, Wages and Employment.
- Against Forced Displacement.
- To Protect Land, Forests and Livelihoods.
- For Cheap Inputs, MSP @ C2+50% and Waiver of Loans.
- For Development of the Lives of the Poor and Jobs in Villages.
- Against Attacks on Rural Welfare.
- Against Fascist Repression.
- Against Sexual Disparity, Communal Attacks, Caste and Sexual Atrocities.
- Against the Degradation of Environment and Ecology.
